Simple Steps for a Healthy Lawn

1. Choose the right grass seed for NH climates such as low maintenance fescue mixes.
2. Don't overwater, no more than 1" of water per week.
3. Test your soil every Spring – pH matters!
4. Mow smart, no shorter than 3" high.

and to protect water quality!**

When Your Lawn Needs Fertilizer

1. Determine how much to apply safely. Measure and apply only what's needed. Store unused fertilizer for use next year.
2. Apply after expected rainfall.
3. Know when and where to apply. Apply at spring green-up and no later than mid-September.
4. Choose the Right Fertilizer. Use low or no phosphorous and formulas of 20N-0P-15K.
