



NEW BOAT REGISTRATIONS & BOAT RENEWALS IN NH

How do I register a new boat in NH?

- NH does not require boats to be titled.
- Boats can be renewed and/or newly registered at retail boat stores, marinas and any Town Clerk who is certified to register boats.
- Boats can be registered in NH if they will spend more than 50% of their time in NH waters.
- Complete this boat application

- Submit to the Town Clerk along with the bill of sale and phone number and email address.
- Government Issued Photo ID/Driver's License is required to process a boat registration.
- In addition to the fees charged by the state of NH, Town Clerk's charge a \$5 local fee to process renewals and registrations. State fees are listed here:

How do I renew a registered NH boat?

- Once a boat is registered in NH, each December, the state mails renewal forms to the registrant.
- Currently, boats cannot be renewed online like motor vehicles.
- Bring or mail your signed renewal form to any town clerk's office and a check completed for the amount on the renewal form, PLUS the \$5 local fee.
- Also include an additional \$1.00 if boat reg & sticker are being mailed to the registrant.
