MINUTES

Open Workshop:

Chairman F. Childs opened the Selectmen's Workshop at 7 PM on Monday October 22, 2012 in the Atkinson Town Hall.

Discussion:

Oil Bids

B. Snicer spoke with SAU #55 Business Administrator George Stokinger regarding the Timberlane School District's results of the oil bid. For the 2012-13 school year, Ronnie's Oil was awarded the heating oil bid for \$3.00 per gallon. G. Stokinger said that the school district employs its own HVAC technician so maintenance is not included. He added that all of the schools in Plaistow use natural gas, and all of the kitchens use propane. The Atkinson, Danville, Hampstead and Sandown schools are heated with oil, but each has a 10,000-gallon tank, making a fill-up just one truckload.

G. Stokinger added that his bids are due on Wednesday, October 24, and he would let the Selectmen's office know the results as soon as they are available.

The Selectmen asked that the bidders for Atkinson not be notified until next week.

Insurance Rates:

B. Snicer gave the Selectmen a copy of the new insurance rates proposed by LGC. T. Barbera asked whether the Contribution Holiday from LGC would be in the form of a refund or deducted from the monthly bills in December 2012, and twice in 2013. B. Snicer will find out from D. Clayton, Atkinson's Benefit Advisor.
