Ms. Travers appeared before the Board of Selectmen to present the following bids to repair the tennis courts at Woodlock Park with the recommendation to award the bid to Vermont Tennis Court in the amount of \$2,171. In addition, Ms. Travers would like Vermont Tennis Court to paint a pickle ball court and youth court in the amount of \$450 bringing the total cost to \$2,621.

W. Friel made a motion to award the bid to repair the tennis courts and to paint pickle ball and youth courts at Woodlock Park to Vermont Tennis Court in the amount of \$2,621. Second for discussion. J. Grosky. The Selectmen confirmed with Ms. Travers that there have been many requests from residents to install a pickle ball court. Mr. Morse agrees the tennis court cracks should be filled. There is no warranty, but repairing the cracks should extend the lifetime of the courts. The last fill was done about 5 years ago which included a paint job and a wash in the amount of \$7,600. 4/0/0.

Sun n Fun Shed

Ms. Travers asked the Board of Selectmen for permission to allow the Camp Counselors and Campers to paint a mural on the shed as a summer activity. The Board of Selectmen approved this request.

Vacancies for Positions

Mr. Consentino inquired about vacant positions in town and whether or not any or all have been filled. Ms. Snicer will look into the status.

Poor Reception in Town

Discussion occurred around the existence of poor reception in Town. Mr. Consentino will take this project on.

School District Update

Mr. Grosky provided an update on happenings within the school district. Danville and Sandown have filed an action in the Superior Court against the School District. The School District is looking to keep Sandown Central open to use as a pre-k/kindergarten program for the district and voters have said the school needs to be closed

down. Mr. Grosky went on to say that the Superintendent's Office has put together a task force to look into different issues involving Sandown and make recommendations. There is an argument that this group met in violation and any recommendation should be considered null and void. There is a dispute going on regarding spending money and the possibility of building a new playground. There are very serious politics at play in this whole situation.

New Business:

Withdrawal from Elder Assistance Expendable Trust Fund – Wheelchair Batteries

W. Friel made a motion to authorize payment from the Elder Assistance Expendable Trust Fund in the amount of \$103.58 with payment to Gene Northam to replace 2 wheelchair batteries. Second. P. Consentino. 4/0/0.
