**New Business:**

*Accept Thermal Imaging Camera from Firefighters Association*

Mr. Phair asked the Board of Selectmen to accept a donation in the amount of \$11,500 for a thermal imaging camera (ISG Model X380) from the Firefighter Association to the Atkinson Fire Department. Mr. Morse explained that a Thermal Imaging Camera looks for hot spots in a fire and thanked the firefighters Association for their generous donation. Mr. Baldwin explained that the camera can also be used to sense body heat and can be useful in finding a missing person.

*Acceptance of NH Highway Safety Agency Grant Agreement for DWI Patrols*

Mr. Baldwin explained this grant to be a source for extra Police patrols to mitigate DWI offences in order to keep the roadway safe.

**H. Morse made a motion to accept the NH Highway Safety Agency Grant Agreement for DWI Patrols in the amount of \$6,915.48, effective 10/1/15 with a completion date of 9/30/16. Second. W. Friel. 3/0/1. P. Consentino abstained from the motion.**
