Discussions:

Domain Expiration

- Wendy stated that she had received an email from Bill Innes that he had been notified that the Atkinson-nh.gov domain would be expiring. On 9/20/2012. The domain registration is held by www.dotgov.gov
- Wendy contacted the company and asked for details and was denied access to this info due to the fact that she was not “the authorized owner”. The owner of record could not even be divulged. She was notified that the account could be updated with the appropriate contacts and account owner if a letter on Town letterhead was drafted by the highest ranking official in town (selectman).
- The original email to Bill Innes stated that the renewal fee is \$125.00 per year.
- We cannot move this domain registration to our current web domain holder Network Solutions for a discounted rate because www.dotgov.gov is one of only a handful of companies authorized to register .gov domains.
- In his capacity as selectman, Todd agreed to draft the letter. The committee agreed that the logical choice as account holder would be the town admin (Bill Innes), that the financial contact would be Sandra and that the technical contact would be Wendy.
- Karl made a motion to purchase the domain renewal for \$125.00, Todd seconded the motion. The vote to purchase was unanimous.

Laptop Purchase

- Wendy did a price comparison for the Town Admin laptop and found the same model for \$200 less.
- The decision was made to forward the newer price to First Choice and have them purchase it.

Door Security Software

- The committee discussed the new door security keypad software and where the software should be installed. It was determined that the software could be installed on the Town Administrators laptop.
